Life Is Precious

“I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; marvelous are thy works; and that my soul knoweth right well” Psalm 139:14.

The life which is given to each of us is a gift from God Himself. It is something so complex in its composition that we cannot help but be amazed by it. It is so precious as to be the very essence of our existence.

“And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul” Gen. 2:7.

“Neither is worshipped with men’s hands, as though he needed anything, seeing he giveth to all life, and breath and all things” Acts 17:25.

The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy; I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly” John 10:10.

Let there be no mistake, and may there be no denial; life is something very, very special – precious, indeed!

Christians Believe in a Culture of Life!

For the first two hundred years of our existence as a nation (1776-1973), America was a culture of life. The innocent and vulnerable were protected from any and all who would harm them.

Both born and unborn were shielded by the full weight of the law. That all changed on January 22, 1973. When the United States Supreme Court handed down its infamous Roe vs. Wade decision, it legalized abortion and started a holocaust on the unborn.

Here we are forty years later, and, to date, fifty-five million babies have been butchered in their mothers’

wombs. The killing of the little ones goes on day and night, year after year.

A Culture of Death Has Come to Reality!

Just three years after Roe vs. Wade (1976), Dr. C. Everette Koop, who served as President Reagan’s Surgeon General (1982-1989) said, “Abortion cannot be a Christian option, except in the almost unheard-of necessity of saving the mother’s life. As we lose our concept of the sanctity of human life, the door is open for unlimited dangers we will regret.”

Dr. Koop warned that social reforms initially designed to relieve the suffering gradually could become “active euthanasia” – the elimination of people who are economically unproductive or ecologically undesirable. Dr. Koop took an equally tough stand against euthanasia: “The prolonging of life cannot be a matter for courts to decide but must remain with the field of trust between patient and physician.”

Well, here we are in 2013, and Dr. Koop’s wise observations have come and are coming to reality.

1. Abortion continues virtually unchecked. About 100,000 unborn babies will be aborted in America every month in 2013.

2. Infanticide is now coming into the national discussion. There are advocates, a growing number of them, who want to legalize the killing of born babies if, for some reason, you are unhappy with your child.

3. Euthanasia is already front and center! Decisions about life and death are being made every day in hospitals and nursing homes all across the land. If the “quality of life” is at a high risk level, the physician huddles with the

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family to make choices about what to do and when to do it. Those decisions are often made based on money available, what the insurance will pay and the level of pain a person is experiencing.

4. Death panels coming?

Very likely it is the case. The liberals say no, but that probably means yes. A number of people who are very familiar with the Obamacare law say that the provision is in the law that will effectively create committees which will decide who gets care and who doesn't. Of course, it will have a nice name, but the results will be the same.

If a committee meets to decide who gets medicine or surgery and who doesn't, it is a death panel.

5. The entertainment industry seems possessed with violence. Movies, video games and other forms of "entertainment" are constantly bombarding the citizenry with killing. It desensitizes everybody and devalues life in the minds of the people.

Abortion Is Murder!

In 1979, Dr. John R. Rice wrote in the ... about abortion. He said:

"The Supreme Court has said that a baby before it is born, is "a nonperson." No, that is simply an excuse of people who want abortion on demand. And the number of babies murdered far exceeds the number of American boys who died in the Vietnam War.

The active murderers are distinguished-looking doctors, men respected in their communities, because now the murder has become legal. These murders are committed in hospitals.

But abortion is murder just

the same!

We ought not to think that any woman is a good citizen or a good Christian or a trustworthy friend if she has her baby murdered. We ought not to think any doctor who helps in murder for money is a trustworthy doctor or a good moral man.

A few years ago, the best doctors in America had hanging on the walls of their offices the Oath of Hippocrates. They counted that oath their own, vowing that they would never help a woman abort a baby.

But now they are not true either to Christian convictions or to ethical considerations of many generations of physicians.

Is the unborn baby a person? Well, it is alive. It has hands and feet, a head, brains and a beating heart. It has hidden in it all the capacity of others made in the image of God. It is alive; then is it not a person?

But someone says that the little one, until a month or two before its birth, could not survive in the world by itself. No, and it couldn't survive if it were six months old or a year old without help. Does that make it all right for a mother to kill the baby who may be a nuisance?"

Oh, how right he was! And how unthinkable it is when anyone under any circumstance starts plotting the elimination of the unborn, the young, the elderly and others who are entrusted to our care.

You may think me harsh when I declare without stammering that these medically orchestrated deaths in the sterile environment of a hospital or a nursing home are acts of murder – but murder it is!

Giving it another name or cloaking it in medical terminologies does not lessen the fact that it is murder!

We Will Not Be Silent on These Issues!

For forty years, I have spoken out loudly and often to rebuke the perpetrators of these dastardly deeds – and we have no intention of giving up or letting up until the killing stops.

We are pro-life! We oppose the death culture with every fiber of our being.

Mercy & Grace

“Do not withhold Your tender mercies from me, O LORD; Let Your loving kindness and Your truth continually preserve me. Oh, satisfy us early with your mercy, That we may rejoice and be glad all our days!” (Psalm 40:11 & 90:14)

Of the ‘letters’ that the Holy Spirit told (inspired) the Apostle Paul to write; only the three to Timothy and Titus use the following three-fold greeting: “Grace, mercy, and peace.” The ‘others’ use the more common “grace and mercy.”

No doubt as one ponders (mediates) on the wonder of **God’s** ‘mercy’ and ‘grace’; the question will likely arise: Do the Holy Scriptures pinpoint where mercy ends and grace begins or are these two marvelous doctrinal ‘truths’ **inseparable?** Personally, this ‘writer’ cannot discern where mercy ends and grace begins; but for this ‘editorial’ we are going to look especially at MERCY: which maybe is first?!

Occasionally, you hear people say that in their opinion we have favorable weather or “we deserve it” or “it is about time”; as though God is somewhat obligated to our whims and desires. But HE is not obligated to us NOR accountable to us either!

A most describable definition of mercy is, not getting what you deserve. Martin Luther said “If we (I) got what I deserved; I would be like a blade of grass” and I question IF we (I) would fair that well!

A good definition of grace would be: getting what I don’t deserve OR unmerited favor or God’s Redemption At Christ’s Expense.

Soberly meditate on the following two verses found in John 3:18 & 36. *“He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already; because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.”* *“He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son, shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him.”* **BUT** by/for the GRACE of God, I would be among the ‘many’ who are yet under the ‘wrath’ of God.

Technically, I believe that ‘we’ who have experienced Salvation in and through Christ Jesus; actually came to HIM for **mercy**; as lost bankrupt ‘sinners’ and God promised when we come that way, HE will also give ‘us’ the gift of Salvation. Ephesians 2:8-9 & Titus 3:5-7. I will share with you two other examples: Luke 18:9-17, 17:11-19.

The BIBLE is a book of GRACE from Genesis 1:1 through Revelation 22:21. Actually it is God’s mercy and grace that ‘we’ even have a BIBLE! A brief definition from the Dictionary of mercy is: “compassion or forbearance shown esp. to an offender or to one subject to one’s power. A blessing

that is an act of divine favor or compassion.” “In mercy and truth Atonement is provided for iniquity; And by the fear of the LORD one departs from evil.” Proverbs 16:6. Grace is the “unmerited divine assistance given man for his regeneration or sanctification. A virtue coming from God.”

Singularly, a person’s greatest NEED is **forgiveness** from a thrice Holy and Just GOD! Speaking of a child of God, notice: *“who once were not a people but are now the people of God who had not obtained mercy but have obtained mercy. Beloved, I beg you as sojourners and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts which war against the soul,”* 1 Peter 2:10-11.

Here we see God’s prevenient GRACE (preparational Grace) at work; working behind the scene, in awakening us of our need of mercy and forgiveness from our living God.

We who of the ‘household of faith’, in the days we are living in; IF we are to see and experience God’s amazing mercy and grace; must take very seriously this admonition: *“For the time has come for judgment to begin at the house of God; and if it begins with us first, ...”* 1 Peter 4:17. Martin Luther shares that if we are not willing to deal with SIN the Bible is a closed Book! *“If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.”* 11 Chronicles 7:14.

As ‘we’ face the stark naked ‘Truth’, we realize that every individual person who is yet unregenerate is only but a ‘heart beat OR breath’ from entering a Christless eternity: we need to ask our living God for boldness/courage to ‘witness/preach the WORD (in love) before they leave this journey of life forever.

I am reminded of a guest speaker in a certain community overhearing a group of ladies **praying** for a very immoral lady in their community. He then asked these burdened Christian Ladies if they had gone and talked to this person about her need of JESUS? NO, but we have been ‘faithfully’ praying for her.

His response was that while they were praying for her and no one talks to her about JESUS; she will go to Hell! As you notice ‘especially’ in the book of Acts (not resolutions) that they preached/testified the WORD where ever they went! I do not believe Satan will prompt you to witness/testify to your neighbor, loved ones, friends about JESUS and His **shed blood** for our sins(and theirs).

As I begin to bring this 'editorial' to a close, let me name *some sins* from God's huge catalog of sins; and as we know there are *sins* of commission and *sins* of omission and that knowing **sin** ALWAYS hinders or separates the 'sinner' from God. It seems to me that it is so easy to let what we call 'Christian Liberty' become a license/freedom, to sin; Grace a pillow to sin upon. *"For you, brethren, have been called to liberty; only do not use liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another."* Galatians 5:13. *"I beseech you therefore brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not be conformed (squeezed) to this world, but be transformed ..."* Romans 12:1 & 2b.

Where should I start naming from the great list of sin that God has in His vocabulary? Well for now, I am going to mention mostly action sins; not the inner sins like: Fretting, anxiety, worry, pride, envy, jealousy, lust, rebellion, etc. Now who would ever think of 'Christian(s)' stealing? But how about withholding that which rightfully belongs to God? That a form of stealing! Have you opposed butchering (abortion) 'infants' in their mother's womb and voted against the same? How do you respect (keep it holy) the first day of the week? (In the New Testament, the 'Sabbath' evidently is the first day of the week)!

Do you subscribe to the 'theory', that sin is sin to one person but not necessarily another? I believe what God calls sin is 'universal' and does not fluctuate. NOW there can be a difference in the forgiven sinner's life of how old they are in Christ and their sensitivity to the Holy Spirit. God doesn't change the cross-bones on the poison bottle of sin. *"This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days say the LORD: I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds I will write them"* Hebrews 10:16. The more we are 'filled' (controlled by) with the Person of the Holy Spirit, the more sensitive 'we' will become toward sin; within and without. How about 'modesty', or being more concerned about the latest fashion/style? Jeremiah 6:15-19, Matthew 5:28; also visa versa. Martin Luther shares so correctly in regards to 'evil thoughts': "You can not keep a bird from flying over your head; but you can keep it from nesting in your hair." So IF you 'dress' (immodestly): whose is the greater sin: the 'dresser or the looker'?

When Joseph was falsely put into prison and was going to appear before the king; he wanted to be clean shaven and have clean clothes. (I'm not against mustaches or breads; but appearance/respect/reverence as 'we' come to *worship the King of kings and Lord of lords is in order!*) Man often quotes this saying: God looks upon the 'heart'; but He also said what is in the 'heart' comes out!

Is your 'congregation' becoming mostly 'entertainment and fun' without your objection, or is a place where the WORD is preached and practiced and a 'house of Prayer'? James

4:17. What do you watch on TV, Video, DVD's, etc? Again often it is said it is not good for children; but *if* it is not good for children: likely neither is it good for your EYES, either! Psalm 101:3

Well we could continue to go on; but let me summarize this way: SIN should be to the born again person like 'waste products' are to the natural body; get rid of it! Romans 7 and Galatians 5:13-26. Martin Luther spoke of how the old Adam (nature, flesh,) needs to be drowned daily; but he found out that the old nature knows how to swim! *"One who turns away his ear from hearing the law, Even his prayer is an abomination"* Proverbs 28:9. Hans Neilsen Hauge mentions that as a 'believer' I am removed from the condemnation of the LAW; but not compliance to the LAW. Romans 8:1.

Prayerfully, the Person of the Holy Spirit has been permitted to do a work now in our hearts; we NEED to Look to the LAMB OF GOD (Old Testament: shadow, the brazen serpent), **Isaiah 1:18, Matthew 1:21.**

I don't know how many of you have that 'little' plaque with the 'sticks' pointing in different directions: but as you get your 'focus' in the right position – you see the Name JESUS, who is the Answer! *"Look to Me, and be saved ..."* Isaiah 45:22.

Does the future for our church, community, state and USA look hopeless then? **Absolutely not** as Christians are like a rudder is to a ship! Abraham was only one person at the time of Sodom and Gomorrah. How many were Jonah, Elijah, etc.?

OH you will be called 'old-fashioned', 'square', 'legalistic', 'narrow-minded' etc., BUT when you see what is at stake, is that asking too much of you? Jesus says: 'Take up thy cross and follow me'. 11 Timothy 3:12: *"Yes, and all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution."* Jesus said: **Matthew 10: 34 & 38, John 7:43. "He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy."** Proverbs 28:13.

Please ponder on 'Joseph' in the Old Testament for example: Genesis 39:7-23. Remember not even one sin will ever enter Heaven - **only** Forgiven SINNERS. OH HOW I NEED MERCY, GRACE and FORGIVENESS CONTINUALLY: **I need JESUS!**

"I, even I, am He who blots out your transgressions for My own sake; And I will not remember your sins." Isaiah 43:25. *"Through the LORD'S mercies we are not consumed, Because His compassions fail not. They ae new every morning; Great is Your faithfulness."* Lamentations 3:22 - 23a.

Questions/Answered

We received a question from a reader about why The New World Translation, the book the Jehovah's Witnesses use for their Bible, changes the word "God" in referring to Jesus in 1 Timothy 3:16.

They make this change primarily because they deny the deity of Christ, and this verse is a problem for them the way God wrote it. But the fact that they made this change does not mean that they were right to do so. Nor does it lessen the impact and the meaning of the verse.

"And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory." 1 Tim. 3:16.

This verse is filled with the fact that Jesus is God incarnate.

A mystery in Scripture is a previously hidden truth which, despite its revelation, still contains a supernatural element. The mystery of godliness is the truth that Jesus Christ was God and that, as the incarnate fullness of the Godhead, He embodied all divine wisdom and power.

This verse shows the eternal existence of Jesus Christ. He neither began at birth nor ended at Golgotha. Bethlehem was the point at which He showed Himself to man in order to fulfill the mission of redemption. He made His appearance to man in a human body. The feet that walked the shores and Sea of Galilee were the very same ones that walked in the fiery furnace with His faithful servants in Daniel 3.

"God was manifest in the flesh" is a simple declaration of the incarnation of the Son of God.

Next, *"justified in the Spirit"* shows that after He was delivered up to death because of our offenses and was raised again for our justification (Rom. 4:25), God, the Father, signified His acceptance in the Spirit by raising Him from the dead.

He was *"seen of angels."* Surely they had watched His departure to earth and the events of His life until He was placed in the tomb, but perhaps this is saying that God sent them to roll the stone away from His grave, making them the very first to see the risen Christ. What a report they must have given concerning their errand to the tomb!

"Preached unto the Gentiles" – Jesus did not die for the Jews only, but for all the people of the world. This news was a part of the Great Commission that Jesus had given to His disciples before He left the earth.

He was *"believed on in the world"* – not believed about or accepted as historical or acknowledged to have spiritual power, but believed on. That signifies personal

abandonment to the Saviour. Thank the Lord for millions who have believed on Him in this world!

Last, He was *"received up into glory."* Yes, He was received up into Glory. He literally went up into the heavens. He was seen by His disciples as He went up (Acts 1). What joy must have awaited Him in His Home! And because He was received up into Glory literally, He will come back to earth literally.

No gloomy fears their souls dismay;

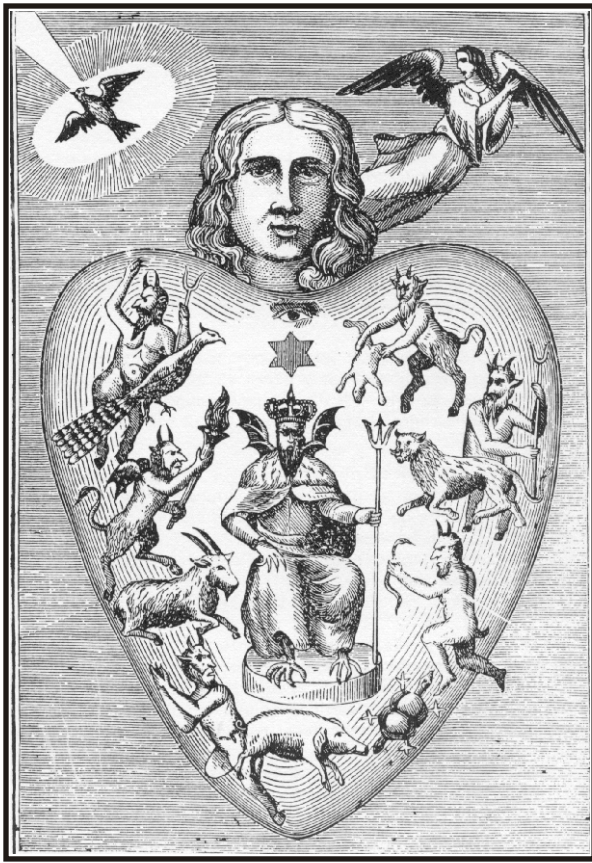

The Seventh Picture

A man's heart, who, after his conversion, knowingly and willingly has gone back to a sinful life and permits sin and Satan to rule.

This seventh picture visualizes a man's inner condition as Christ himself describes it in the Gospel: *"When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest and finding none, he saith, I will return unto my house whence I came out. And when he cometh, he findeth it swept and garnished. Then goeth he, and taketh to him seven other spirits more wicked than himself; and they enter in, and dwell there; and the last state of that man is worse than the first"* (Luke 11:24-26).

What a horrible sight. Satan dwells, rules, and commands in the heart which was once God's temple and the Holy Spirit's dwelling. The old sins and abominations are back again. The horrible creatures are again firmly established there and make havoc as if it were their own possession.

How did it all happen? The man did not appreciate the grace he had received. He neglected to cleanse himself of his former sins, and did not exercise himself in piety and holiness. He that does not go forward will go backward. Here there is no standing still. Here one must earnestly strive to enter the narrow gate, and firmly and boldly go forward on the narrow way. He who does not earnestly

hate sin, does not renounce the world with its lusts, and does not shun every action of sin will soon be drawn by the devil's cunning, the sin's enticements, and the world's pleasure, into their net. Then will the words of the Apostle be fulfilled: *"But it has happened unto them according to the proverb, the dog is turned to his vomit; and the sow that was washed to her wallowing in the mire"* (II Peter 2:22). The thoughtless sinner who neglects watchfulness and yields to his sinful desires and inclinations falls back into his old sins.

In the picture the Holy Spirit is seen forsaking the heart. He cannot dwell with the unclean heart and spirit. How can a heart be God's temple and at the same time the devil's dwelling?

The angel, representing God's grace, goes away sorrowfully, but he holds up his hands to indicate that Christ still has compassion with the miserable sinner. His position indicates that he might be saying: *"If thou hadst known, even thou, at least in this thy day, the things which belong to thy peace! But now they are hid from thine eyes"* (Luke 19:42). God's arms are still stretched out to thee, and the Redeemer's heart is open for thee." But the sinner does not listen. He looks arrogantly at the world and heeds nothing, neither secret sins, nor open transgressions. He does not recognize the sins in his heart, nor does he see the abyss toward which he is heading. Faith is dead. The star of hope has lost its light. The god of this world has blinded his mind.

O backslider! Such is your condition when you have once confessed your sins, repented of them, and tasted forgiveness, but have not by God's grace watched against sin. You have thrown yourself again into the arms of evil. The devil and sin take a firmer hold and rage in you as their helpless slave.

O friend! Be on your guard so that you do not fall back into the old ways and habits. If you have once received grace, renounced sin and Satan, declared war on all vice, then continue forever their sworn enemy and never let them into your heart. Pursue the enemies and flee from them. They will always return and seek to recapture their old palace and demand their old rights. If you give them room, the battle is lost, and your last state will be worse than the first. Put your trust in God. He alone can sustain you and give you victory over your enemies. If you stumble and fall, stand up again and fight manly! Never compromise with sin. Always hold firmly to the Almighty hand of the Saviour. He can and will help you. His arm is not shortened. He is the stronger who can overcome the strong, take away Satan's armor, bind him, and cast him out. He can set you free. Why should you then any longer let Satan possess your heart when it can be God's holy temple?

“Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.” Romans 12:21

One summer I was at a gathering of old high school acquaintances when someone behind me tapped me on my shoulder. As my eyes drifted over the woman's name tag, my mind drifted back in time. I remembered a tightly folded note that had been shoved through the slot on my locker. It had contained cruel words of rejection that had shamed me and crushed my spirit. I remember thinking, Somebody needs to teach you a lesson on how to treat people! Although I felt as if I were reliving my adolescent pain, I mustered up my best fake smile; and insincere words began coming out of my mouth.

We began to converse. A sad story of a difficult upbringing and of an unhappy marriage began to pour out of her. As it did, the words *“root of bitterness”* from Hebrews 12:15 popped into my head. That's what I'm feeling, I thought. After all these years, I still had a deep root of bitterness hidden with me, twisting around and strangling my heart.

Then these words came to my mind: *“Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good”* (Rom. 12:21).

We talked. We even shared some tears. Neither of us mentioned the long-ago incident. God taught someone a lesson that afternoon – a lesson of forgiveness and of letting go of bitterness. He taught it to me.

Rodney (Gipsy) Smith

Rodney (Gipsy) Smith (1860-1947) was one of the most remarkable preachers of the nineteenth and twentieth centuries. He was also called to preach from almost the moment of his conversion. He and his family were gypsies in England, virtually homeless, but his father had experienced an unusual conversion.

Shortly afterward, on November 17, 1876, Rodney attended chapel and went forward following the sermon by George Warner. He heard someone whisper, "Oh, it's only a gipsy boy."

Running home, he told his father that he had been converted. Though illiterate, he began carrying around a Bible, an English dictionary and a Bible dictionary, trying to learn to read them. People laughed at him, but he said, "Never you mind. One day I'll be able to read them, and I'm going to preach too. God has called me to preach."

As he worked on his reading, he began to practice preaching by going out into the fields and preaching to the turnips. At age seventeen, he stood on a small corner near his gypsy wagon and gave a brief testimony.

It was his first attempt at preaching – but it wasn't his last. He became a worldwide evangelist, preaching to thousands at a time and carrying on his phenomenal ministry for seventy years, until his death at age eighty-seven.

Take note of what is written here!

“For ye were bought with a price” with the precious blood of Christ. *Ye are not your own*” so that yours is not the privilege of doing as you please with your body and your soul, your heart and your thoughts. But if you believe on Christ then your bodies too are the temples of the

Holy Spirit. As mysterious as this is and as super-reasonable as this is that God's Spirit shall dwell in you it is nevertheless just as true as God is truthful. *“Shall I then take away the members of Christ, and make them members of a harlot?”* (1 Corinthians 6:15). In 1 Corinthians 3:16, 17 we also read, *“Know ye not that ye are a temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you? If any man destroyeth the temple of God him will God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, and such are ye.”*

Having had one's sins forgiven repeatedly but one finds the same sin remaining it becomes too unreasonable to be able to believe. “No, it is unreasonable” man says. Another will say “I am forsaken of God, and abandoned to an unrepentant state of mind; I am lost.”

Therefore, he who is being attacked by sin must have mastered a unique art, namely that of persisting in faith, if he is to be saved. For after having tried out all rules one shall finally have to come to the conclusion that no rule, no vigilance, no abhorrence, no prayer, no struggle avails here. Here avails only the wonderful faith which in the midst of sin can take refuge in the bosom of the offended God and only through the atoning blood possess Him.

There is more to learn in this. You have really learned something when you can actually believe that, regardless of how serious sin is, it is nevertheless removed from you and laid upon the Lamb of God. You know then that these sins that you see residing in you in reality do not lie upon you but are upon the back of Christ. To be in possession of this knowledge is to possess the mightiest power with which to set you free.

Therefore it is possible not only to defeat our enemy but also to capture him and make him fight in our ranks.

The prophet Isaiah tells of “*fly(ing) upon the shoulders of the Philistines*” (Is. 11:14 KJV). These Philistines were their deadly foes, but this passage suggests that they would be able not only to conquer the Philistines but also to ride on their backs to further triumphs. Just as a skilled sailor can use a head wind to carry him forward, by using its impelling power to follow a zigzag course, it is possible for us in our spiritual life, through the victorious grace of God, to turn completely around the things that seem most unfriendly and unfavorable. Then we will be able to say continually, “*What has happened to me has really served to advance the gospel*” (Phil. 1:12) from Life More Abundantly.
