## **Our Greatest Need**

Others think it is the next fix for their drug habit. For sick people it might be some type of medicine or medical treatment. Each reader can probably come up with their own greatest need depending on their circumstances. There can be many things that seem like they would be the greatest need in our life. Whatever it is, we will put a priority on it and work hard to achieve or attain it.

Based on the word of God, our <u>Greatest Need</u> is to have God forgive us our sins before we die. If we are not forgiven, we face an eternity separated from God and will face everlasting punishment. Even though some of our earthly needs can seem very great, they are all temporary. Since we are mortals, at some point our life on earth will be over. However, since we have eternal souls and are spiritual beings, we will live on in eternity. Therefore, our eternal life is more important than our temporal life, and we should plot a course that will insure that we will spend eternity with God.

They consider themselves too intelligent, cosmopolitan and sophisticated for such weakness and nonsense. They may never ever get to the point that they have a spiritual need of salvation at all. To them it is all fairytales and myths (*I Cor 1:18 – "For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God"*). They are self-sufficient in their own eyes. Maybe they are afraid others will make fun of them. I think virtually every one of us have been there.

Also, our Greatest Need is so important, that the enemy of our souls has worked overtime to sow seeds of confusion, error and doubt. In our modern society, we are told not to worry about our guilt, it's probably someone else's fault anyway. When guilt comes into our conscience, we dismiss it. Rather than being ashamed of ourselves we excuse ourselves. Then, as we continue down the path of rebellion our conscience becomes seared, and it becomes a spiral downward. Often depression and other unhealthy things can then affect us. Unless we watch ourselves carefully, we can expose ourselves to temptations that are too strong for us to resist in our own strength. There are no shortages of temptations in our wicked world, especially when everything is so accessible in magazines, books, bad company and the Internet. If we continue in our rebellion, God can give us over to a reprobate mind. Romans 1:27-32 gives a list of wicked things that man can give themselves over to, but

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he says in verse 28 "And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient (fitting)." In other words, they will get to a point where God will turn them over to a cursed conscience and reject them completely.

Satan confuses us, and so does our old nature. Apart from God, we look for help in all of the wrong places. False religions, alcohol/drugs, work, relationships etc. False religions can be especially dangerous because they can bind us up in false teachings and lead us farther and farther from God and truth. However, no matter how long and noble our list of priorities is, at the very top should be "<u>Our Greatest Need</u>," our salvation, and where we will spend all of eternity.

Just as many people are clueless about how to be saved, and usually try to do good works as a means of pleasing God and getting to heaven, the Bible says it cannot be done by works. Instead, the Bible gives us a clear way to be saved. The Bible is God's holy, perfect and God-breathed word, and we can trust it completely. Romans 3:28 says "Therefore, we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law." This faith is in the Lord Jesus as our Savior. Romans 10:8-9, 13 says "But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach; that if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved" "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved'.

As you flip the coin the results are: John 11:44 – 12:11!


Do you think that Satan has given-up in using these attacks?

#### No Trouble with Demons

Jesus seemed to have no trouble with <u>demons</u>. Read through the four Gospels, and you will see how common place it was for Jesus to encounter and cast out demons. In the Gospels (NIV translation) there are 86mentions of demons, counting also "impure spirits" – as

they are often called. In every encounter with a demonpossessed person, Jesus effortless cast out the demons, apparently sending them into the <u>Abyss</u>, so that they trouble people no more! Even a Legion of demons was no challenge for Him.

Jesus' human opponents once claimed His power over <u>demons</u> to be Satanic! In response, Jesus spoke truth "...If Satan opposes himself and is divided, he cannot stand; his end has come. #### Okla. makes abortion illegal

Oklahoma Republican Gov. Kevin Stitt on Tuesday [April 12] signed a bill that makes performing an abortion in the state illegal, as Republican-led states across the country rush to restrict abortion access while the Supreme Court weighs the fate of Roe v. Wade.

"I promised Oklahomans that I would sign every pro-life bill that hits my desk, and that's what we're doing today," said Stitt, who described himself as a father of six. "We want Oklahoma to be the most pro-life state in the country. We want to outlaw abortion in the state of Oklahoma."

Stitt was joined at the signing ceremony Tuesday morning by members of the Legislature, faith leaders and a number of anti-abortion groups who have advocated for more anti-abortion legislation. He sat at a desk featuring a poster with the words "Life is a human right," which others behind him also held.

The bill, which passed the Senate last year and the House earlier this month with more than 80 support in both chambers, makes performing an abortion a felony.

Anyone convicted would face as much as 10 years in prison and a \$100,000 fine.

The law makes an exception if the life of the woman is in danger but has no exception for rape or incest.

If it is not blocked by the courts, the bill is scheduled to take effect in the summer when the Oklahoma Legislature adjourns. Unlike several other abortion bans proposed in Oklahoma this session, it does not include the emergency clause that allows a bill to take effect as soon as it's signed by the governor.

The bill's future will probably hinge on a Supreme Court decision expected in the summer, when the justices will rule on Mississippi's 15-week abortion ban in a case that could overturn or significantly roll back Roe v. Wade, the landmark 1973 ruling that guaranteed the right to abortion nationwide.

From Florida to Idaho to Arizona, Republicans have moved to restrict abortion while Democratic-led states have tried to protect access to the procedure. ...

White House press secretary Jen Psaki criticized the state law, calling it an "unconstitutional attack on women's rights" and among the most extreme anti-abortion bills in the country.

"Make no mistake: The actions today in Oklahoma are a part of a disturbing national trend attacking women's rights and the Biden Administration will continue to stand with women in Oklahoma and across the country in the fight to defend their freedom to make their own choices about their futures," she said in a statement.

In oral arguments last year, conservative Supreme Court justices, who hold the majority on the 6-to-3 court, seemed open to overturning Roe v. Wade and 50 years of jurisprudence that guarantees a fundamental right to abortion.

Alexis McGill Johnson, president of Planned Parenthood Action Fund, a non-profit that advocates for abortion rights, said on Twitter on Tuesday that her organization will challenge the Oklahoma bill in court, calling it an "unconstitutional law."

"We are at a tipping point for abortion rights nation-wide," she wrote.

#### Florida governor signs bill stripping Disney of self-governing authority

April 22 (Reuters) - Florida Governor Ron DeSantis on Friday signed a bill that strips Walt Disney Co of self-governing authority at its Orlando-area parks in retaliation for its opposition to a new law that limits the teaching of LGBTQ issues in schools.

Disney did not immediately comment on the bill's signing.

DeSantis is a potential 2024 Republican presidential candidate who has courted conservative voters on issues such as immigration, abortion and LGBTQ rights.

With his latest move against Disney, DeSantis is attempting to burnish his conservative credentials by showing he is willing to stand up to what he described as a "woke" company based in California that does not share Florida's values.

Disney initially did not publicly oppose the LGBTQ legislation last month, prompting criticism from that community and some employees. The company later condemned the law and said it would suspend political donations in Florida pending a review.

The law, dubbed the "don't say gay" bill by critics, bans classroom instruction on sexual orientation or gender identity for children in kindergarten through third grade. DeSantis backed the measure, saying it would give parents more control over their children's education. Opponents call it a thinly veiled attempt to marginalize gay and transgender students, or the children of queer parents.

At a fundraiser in Seattle on Thursday, President Joe Biden weighed in on the clash between Disney and Florida Republicans. He said efforts to impose such constraints "have nothing to do with traditional conservative doctrine."

"I respect conservatives. There's nothing conservative about deciding you're going to throw Disney out of its present posture because Mickey Mouse ... should ... not be able to say, you know, gay."

While the bill appears to be an attack on Disney and sprawling Orlando theme parks, experts say the financial impact of the legislation on the company and the state is unclear at this stage.

DeSantis rushed the bill through the statehouse, pushing it through within three days of a special session, but it will not take effect until June 2023, giving the two sides time to adjust to the new reality

#### Does Scripture Say Anything about Climate?

Human perspectives on climate change vary from one extreme to the other, but the BIBLE'S position on climate is rock solid.

Genesis describes three droughts and God's promise to maintain the overall stability of Earth's climate.

As Climate change conversation(s) squeeze their way into so many topics, yet climate research is rife with confusion. Which scientists are right — those who say manmade pollution and greenhouse gases cause most global warming, or those who say these may only play a minor role? Even expert opinions vary to extremes. In contrast, GENESIS makes confident statements about Earth's climate.

The 2009 Climategate fiasco illustrates the confusion inside climate research. Extracted emails exposed how certain climate researchers suppressed the work of scientists who disagreed with them. An embarrassing placard at Glacier National Park in Montana also shows confusion. The old sign said human activity warms the world enough to melt glaciers! It stated, "Computer models indicate the glaciers will all be gone by the year of 2020." BUT the glaciers in the park remain today so park officials changed the sign. Whether through scientific suppression or waffling words, climate science seems to shift like the daily weather forecast!

In contrast, the Word of God stands <u>forever!</u> For example, Genesis lists three big famines that fit Ice Age climate shifts. Noah's Flood warmed oceans and powered volcanoes that caused Earth's Ice Age. Centuries later, oceans cooled, volcanoes calmed, and ice sheets melted. As the Ice Age faded, the Middle East transitioned from lush to arid. Abram traveled across today's Iraq to Egypt across a "well -watered" land that stands dry today." After he arrived in Canaan, Genesis 12:10 says <u>"Abram went down to Egypt to dwell there, for the famine was severe in the land.</u>" CROPS won't grow without rain! He headed to Egypt since ancient Egyptians relied more on the NILE River when rains failed to fall on their fields.

Scripture records the next major drought during Isaac's time saying, "*There was a famine in the land, besides the first famine that was in the days of Abraham.*" Later, the Lord used Joseph as top leader in Egypt to save many people through a third drought recorded in Genesis. Seven years without rain certainly counts as a climate change! That extreme weather had nothing to do with industrial pollution. Scripture's history and clues on the ground together show that today's dry Middle East had a wet past.

While Christians should lead in protecting God's Creation, <u>no</u> Bible believer should buy into <u>Climate alarmism</u>! This says that human activity can destroy the Planet. What about God's <u>promise</u> to Noah? After the Flood, He said, *"While the earth remains, seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, winter and summer, and day and night shall not cease."* God promised farmable land, not a destroyed earth!

The Creator <u>doesn't make junk!</u> He made Earth's atmosphere strong enough to sustain the people He loves even when some of those people fail to take care of His Creation. Mankind makes mistakes. Our faults bleed into science and society! In contrast, three droughts and a Genesis promise show the certainty of our great Creator's words.

#### The Blood of God

"Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood." (Acts 20:28)

From the very beginning of sin, God laid out His means of dealing with sin in people's lives: The Blood of An Innocent Victim. When Adam and Eve fell into sin, God did the following: "And the LORD God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife, and clothed them." (Genesis 3:21) The life of living things is in the blood and it takes the sacrifice of life to atone before God for the infraction against His Holy Will. This is what the sacrificial system in the Old Testament demonstrated to the people. "For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you on the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood by reason of the life that makes atonement." (Leviticus 17:11) The word "atonement" means "to cover over," in other words the blood covered over the sins of the people before God, yet it would never remove them. "For the Law, since it has only a shadow of the good things to come and not the very form of things, can never by the same sacrifices year by year, which they offer continually, make perfect those who draw near. Otherwise, would they not have ceased to be offered, because the worshipers, having once been cleansed, would no longer have had consciousness of sins? But in those sacrifices there is a reminder of sins year by year. For it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins. (Hebrews 10:1-4)

The blood sacrifices in the Old Testament were done upon animals which had no sin, because there was no pronouncement of sin upon them in the curse which God brought upon the earth and mankind. They were sinless substitutes as well, and their blood could cover the wrong done, but not remove it. When we get to the New Testament, we find something similar, yet profoundly different. The blood of Jesus isn't just the blood of a perfect and sinless man. It is the blood of the Only begotten Son of God who became true man – True God and True Man. Therefore it is a divine-human blood and that is why it is able to completely remove the sin from the repentant and believing person. When John the Baptist saw Jesus he cried out, *"Behold the Lamb of God Who takes away the sin of the World"* (John 1:29)

People have a hard time comprehending this. They reason the following: "God is a Spirit with no physical body and therefore has no blood to shed. Jesus was a sinless man and shed His blood on the cross, but it was the blood of a sinless man alone, and not the blood of God, because that would be stating that God died when Jesus died." Let us set aside our human reasoning and look instead to the testimony of the Scripture that Jesus, the Son of God, died for your sins. As the Scripture at the top of the page states: "God purchased His church with His own blood." Instead of sitting in a quandary about it, simply rejoice in what the Lord God has done for you.

Since this Blood of Jesus removes sin from us, we can approach God openly and with confidence. "Since therefore, brethren, we have confidence to enter the holy place by the blood of Jesus." (Heb. 10:19) We can now come before God directly and receive Grace to help in time of need. Even the High Priests in the Old Testament couldn't do that. They approached God in absolute fear that if they hadn't done everything right or brought the wrong sacrifice, they would be consumed on the spot. "And the LORD said to Moses, 'Tell your brother Aaron that he shall not enter at any time into the holy place inside the veil, before the mercy seat which is on the ark, lest he die; for I will appear in the cloud over the mercy seat." (Leviticus 16:2)

Since the Blood of Jesus removes our sins from us, we now have a Biblical definition of what forgiveness of sins entails. *"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."* (I John 1:9) The word "forgive" means "to send away." God takes the sin that belongs to us and "sends it away" to Jesus who bears it in our place.

In fact God not only decides to remove the sins from our lives, but He also forgets that they ever happened. "This is the covenant that I will make with them After those days, says the Lord: I will put My laws upon their heart, And upon their mind I will write them," He then says, "And their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more." (Hebrews 10:16-17) It's absolutely astounding that the Omniscient God decides to forget what He has removed from us with His own Blood! Judgment Day for the believer will not be a time to give an account of our sins since they are no longer part of the record of our lives!

That is the beauty of the Blood of God which takes away our sins. Does this truth not give us a greater appreciation of what we receive when we take the Lord's Supper?

Leonard J. Pearce went to an Alcoholics Anonymous meeting last fall but drank beer before and after the session.

He wound up stealing a four-wheel-drive vehicle from the Webster Fire Department but didn't bother opening the garage doors of the fire station before taking off.

Pearce, 22, of Rostraver Township, entered guilty pleas for burglary, theft, receiving stolen property and criminal mischief before Judge Daniel Ackerman in Westmore-land County Pleas Court.

He said he had a quart of beer before the AA meeting and later got a ride to a bar in Donora where he had another dozen beers or so. He was unclear on how he stole the vehicle from the fire station.

Authorities said that in addition to crashing through the garage door, Pearce donned a fireman's hat, coat and boots. He drove the vehicle about 14 miles and left it parked in Stockdale in Washington County.

Assistant Public Defender Richard Victoria told Ackerman that Pearce, who had had previous problems with alcoholism, had been examined recently by psychiatrists and was competent to stand trial (*Greensburg Tribune-Review, Greensburg, Pennsylvania*).

I have long lost the date of this article, but I would say it was sometime around 1983-85. Regardless, I was always amazed by that title:

Christian, beware how thou thinkest <u>lightly of sin</u>! Take heed lest thou fall by little and little. *Sin, a little thing*? Is it not a poison? Who knows its deadliness? Sin, a little thing? Do not the little foxes spoil the grapes? Doth not the tiny coral insect build a rock in which wrecks a navy? Do not little strokes fell lofty oaks? Will not continual droppings wear away stones? SIN, a <u>little thing</u>? It girded the Redeemer's head with thorns, and pierced His heart! It made Him suffer anguish, bitterness, and woe. Could you weigh the least sin in the scales of eternity, you would fly from it as from a serpent, and abhor the least appearance of evil. Look upon all sin as that which crucified the **Savior** and you will see it be *"exceeding sinful."*

#### **Atomic Blasts On Sodom**

"Then the Lord rained down burning sulfur on Sodom and Gomorrah – from the LORD out of the heavens." (Genesis 19:24)

Genesis 18 and 19 record the judgment and destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah – cities so evil that their inhabitants attempted to rape the angels sent to them. The BIBLE records the judgement – fire rains down from the sky and the cities are destroyed!

Of course, to modern scholars and critics of the Bible the account is dismissed as a myth, and the destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah an event that never took place. And there has never been any remnant of any city that would fit the description of the account ... until now!

The cities of Sodom and Gomorrah would have been located in the region of the Dead Sea. Seven miles northeast of the Dead Sea is a city called <u>Tall el-Hamman</u>, it has in recent time been the focus of an extensive multi-national archaeologist's excavation. Those involved in the excavation include archaeologists, geologists, geochemists, geomorphologists, mineralogists, paleobotanists, sedimentologists, medical doctors, and cosmic impact experts.

After fifteen excavations, the team published its conclusions. The conclusions were stunning. They placed the city about 3,600 years ago, which is within the generally accepted period of Sodom and Gomorrah. What they found set apart the ruins from virtually any other city ever excavated. They came to the conclusion that the city was destroyed — suddenly, violently, cataclysmically.

How was it destroyed? <u>Fire from the sky</u>! The blast was so great that the scientists likened it to that of an <u>atomic bomb</u>! In fact they believe that the force of the blast was <u>greater</u> than the atomic bomb of Hiroshima ... a thousand times greater – or the equivalent of a thousand atomic bombs?

The force that destroyed the city was so powerful that the temperature of the air rose above 3,600 Fahrenheit. Mudbrick houses, clay vessels, swords, shields, and spears began to <u>melt</u>!

According to the scientists, none of the estimated  $\underline{8,000}$  people or animals within the <u>city survived</u>, just as in the account of Genesis. In fact, it appears that wood and small plants were blasted into tiny diamond-like structures! Other finds indicated the melting of elements that require temperatures of 4,435% Fahrenheit! As for the vegetation, it appears to have been wiped out as it was written "*and also the vegetation of the land*." Further, it appears that the destruction caused the land to be covered

with salt – also echoing the account in Genesis.

It is yet another example of science catching up with the Bible. And it's striking for this to be revealed in our generation! For our culture once identified with the morality of Abraham – now it identifies more with that of Sodom – and now the stones cry out, warning of judgment.

**Be confident in the Word of GOD!** <u>In the end it</u> <u>will be proven true.</u> In the meantime, live by it, stand by it, and overcome by it.
