Courage Overcoming the World

"These things I have spoken to you, so that in Me you may have peace. In the world you have tribulation, but take courage; I have overcome the world." (John 16:33)

hen we think of the promises of God, we do not usually recall this promise from Jesus. But it is a promise. The word translated *tribulation* means heavy affliction. Jesus' disciples had been promised peace, but here, He promised them trouble. One of the world's primary characteristics is trouble. Jesus would depart and the disciples would face grief, hatred, persecution and pressure. But Jesus encouraged His followers to have courage as a continuing characteristic of their lives. And, present day believers in Christ need the same encouragement. We should not be surprised when trials come into our lives, nor need we become disheartened. Jesus is our peace (Eph. 2:14), and through Him and His sacrifice at the cross we have peace with God (Rom. 5:1) and the peace of God (Phil. 4:7). In v. 33 above note the contrast between peace "in Me" and tribulation "in the world."

Charles Spurgeon, a prince of preachers in the 19th century, suggested these actions when we face tribulation: "Look upward to your heavenly Father, and behold Him pure and holy. Do you know that you are one day to be like Him? Will you easily be conformed to His image? Will you not require much refining in the furnace of affliction to purify you? Next, Christian, turn your eye downward. Do you know what foes you have beneath your feet? You were once a servant of Satan, and no king

will willingly lose his subjects. Do you think that Satan will let you alone? No, he will always be at you. Expect trouble, therefore, Christian, when you look beneath you...Then look around you. Where are you? You are in an enemy's country, a stranger and a sojourner. The world is not your friend...Be assured that you shall find enemies everywhere...Lastly, look within you, into your own heart, and observe what is there. Sin and self are still within. Ah, if you had no devil to tempt you, no enemies to fight you, and no world to ensnare you, you will still find in yourself evil enough to shake you greatly, for 'the heart is deceitful above all things and beyond cure.' Expect trouble then, but don't be despondent on account of it, for God is with you to help and to strengthen you."

Jesus overcame the world at the cross. He was victorious over "the prince of this world" (John 12:31; 14:30; 16:11). His followers can, indeed, take courage.

I have been very thankful to the Lord for the opportunity afforded me to travel to India for ministry there. Each time has been rich in fellowship and preaching opportunities. But it never fails. When it is time to go home, I have great anticipation. I can't wait! The journey is long and tiring and, sometimes, kind of miserable. One time on a plane I was seated between two rather large men who slept for hours using my shoulders as pillows. I could hardly move. It was unpleasant but knowing what awaited me at home gave me great encouragement and motivation to persevere. The arduous trip was worth it. Yes, and this journey called life is worth it as well, even with all its troubles. Henry Ward Beecher once said: "Troubles are often the tools by

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which God fashions us for better things." And, the best is yet to come for those who trust, not in what they do, but in Jesus and what He has done! Surely it is true that God's graced people know earth's temporary trials are but a prelude to heaven's eternal joys. So, be encouraged. Press on in Jesus!

Making a Vow

The vows we made when we were wed are viewed seriously in God's sight, regardless of how lightly they are regarded by the world or even some Christians or the church (and today increasingly so)! For example: Psalm 15 begins by asking who shall abide in the LORD'S tabernacle and who shall dwell in His Holy Hill. Verse 4b answers that, "He who swears to his own hurt and does not change". In other words, he that gives an oath (vow/promise) and then doesn't change, even though it costs him, is someone the LORD is pleased with to dwell in HIS "tabernacle" (Dwelling place). "God is not a man, that He should lie, Nor, a son of man that He should repent. Has He said, and will He not do? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good"? (Numbers 23:19)

"'If a man makes a vow to the LORD, or swears an oath to bind himself by some agreement, he shall not break his word; he shall do according to all that proceeds out of his mouth." (Numbers 30:2)

Read Matthew 23:1-11

"But all their works they do to be seen of men..., But he that is greatest among you shall be your servant." (Matthew 23:5 & 11)

NCAA Won't Hold Championships in States That Bans Biological Males From Competing in Women's Sports.

The Shroud of Turin: Real or a Hoax

A Scientific Perspective – Carol Hoikkala

The Shroud of Turin is a centuries old linen cloth that has been scrutinized and studied more than any other historical artifact. The debate that continues is whether or not it is the burial cloth of Jesus Christ. Until the 19th century most believed it to be a forgery. However, due to today's modern technology millions now believe it to be the actual cloth.

What changed the view of the people was that, "in 1898, photographer Secondo Pia was commissioned by the Church to take photographs, which when developed, produced a startling discovery that the Shroud contained photographic qualities that revealed the face and body of a man..." (B. Houston – Shroud of Turin: Hoax or Evidence)

Early on, science had believed that the Shroud of Turin dated back about the 13th or 14th century. However, "New research on the pollen found on the shroud ...also sets a possible 1st century date and link to the Sudarium of Oviedo which is believed by many to be the face cloth of Jesus and has a 1st century dating." (ibid)

A Biblical Perspective

For a Biblical perspective on the Shroud of Turin it is necessary to provide some historical background.

The Prophet Daniel foretold (Daniel 11) that a vicious tyrant and enemy of the Jewish people would come on the scene and set up "the abomination of desolation" in the Holy Temple. This was fulfilled when in 175 BC a Syrian King named Antiochus Epiphanes came to power. The name Epiphanes means – <u>God made manifest.</u>

Antiochus set up an idol of a pagan god thereby converting the Holy temple in Jerusalem into a temple of Zeus. The Maccabees called this idol <u>"the abomination</u> <u>of desolation."</u> Since there was no real Zeus, what Antiochus made was an idol of himself – it was *his face* on the idol.

Antiochus Epiphanes serves as a foreshadowing of the Anti-Christ spoken of by Jesus in Matthew 24:15.

The Shroud: A Hebraic View:

Stan Farr, (www.rabbiyeshua) in his teaching, "Dan-

<u>iel, Time and Eternity</u>," gives insight into why the Shroud of Turin can't be the burial cloth of Jesus:

1. The face shown on the cloth looks too good. Jesus was beaten to the point of being unrecognizable – 'His visage (appearance) was marred more than any man...' (Isaiah 52:14.)

2. The cloth shows a person with coins on the eyes, which is a burial custom of the Greeks. Yeshua/Jesus was buried by Torah observant Jewish men; they would not have used a Pagan burial practice.

3. The Bible gives overwhelming evidence that the Shroud isn't the burial cloth of Jesus. John 19:40 says, *Then, they took the body of Jesus, and bound it in strips of linen with spices, as the custom of the Jews is to bury.*" The Jewish burial custom was to first dip the *strips* of linen in a mixture of myrrh and aloes (v. 39) and then wrap the body mummy style. The Shroud is a full-length sheet, not strips.

4. On the first day of the week, when Peter and the other disciple ran to the tomb they found the linen cloths lying there (John 20:5) And "*then the other disciple, who came to the tomb first…he saw and believed.*" (John 20:8). What the 'other disciple' would have seen to cause him to believe was an empty hardened cast. The only way out of the cast would have been for Jesus to pass through it.

5. For over a century now, images have been fashioned from the image on the Shroud. A study that has been done says the image is consistent with that of Zeus to the point that it would hold up in a court of law. God commanded that NO graven images were to be made, therefore He wouldn't have allowed an image of YESHUA/JESUS to be left behind.

In Conclusion

Since there is <u>no real image</u> of **Yeshua/Jesus** any image that is said to be of Him is of a false Messiah.

Jesus gave a warning when HE said, "Therefore when you see the <u>abomination of desolation</u>, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place (whoever reads, let him understand) then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains." (Matthew 24: 15 & 16).

In the Torah (the first five books of the BIBLE also known as the Pentateuch), the observant Jew will know the image set up in the Temple and will flee to the mountains – the <u>place prepared</u> for them by GOD. Those who are ignorant of the Torah's teachings will be deceived by the image. Believing it to be the Messiah, they will submit to and worship the "<u>Abomination of desolation.</u>"

What About Hell? - Part II

"He also will drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is mixed in full strength in the cup of His anger; and he will be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb. And the smoke of their torment goes up forever and ever; and they have no rest day and night, those who worship the beast and his image, and whoever receives the mark of his name." (Rev. 14:10-11)

This is the second in a series of messages on the denials of Hell by the modern church, some of their reasons behind them and a biblical response to each one.

False Ideas Presented Today: Hell is not eternal

This view is one of the most popular views today. It seems to uphold both the justice and mercy of God. It states that there is a hell, but that when people go there, they are burned up and cease to exist. This is called annihilation. This has been the teaching of the Jehovah's Witnesses and Seventh Day Adventists, and has now found its way into main stream Christianity.

What are some verses they are using to back this up? Malachi 4:1&3 says, "For behold, the day is coming, burning like a furnace; and all the arrogant and every evildoer will be chaff; and the day that is coming will set them ablaze," says the LORD of hosts, "so that it will leave them neither root nor branch." ... 'And you will tread down the wicked, for they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet on the day which I am preparing, 'says the LORD of hosts. '" They say that this proves that the wicked are burned up.

Matt. 10:28 says, "And do not fear those who kill the body, but are unable to kill the soul; but rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell." So they say that this proves that people are annihilated body and soul in the fire and don't have to suffer eternally.

Biblical Response

When the Bible uses the word destruction (as in Matt. 10:28, Phil. 3:18-19, II Thess. 1:9 and II Pet. 3:7) in reference to the unbelievers, it does not mean annihilation. The Greek word is "loosed from" or separated. In other words, the ungodly people's "destruction" is the eternal separation from God and all His Goodness, Grace, Love, Glory, Power, etc. It is not the end of existence, just the end of life.

The punishment in Hell is with fire (Matt. 13:49-50) and it never ceases. Jesus will say to the ungodly: "Depart from Me, accursed ones, into the <u>everlasting fire</u>, prepared for the devil and his angels." (Matt. 25:41) Jesus described this punishment as "<u>eternal punishment</u>." (Matt. 25:46) Eternal means without end, because this same verse describes heaven as "eternal life" with the same exact words. If hell is not eternal, then neither is heaven.

Jesus described hell as having "worms which do not die and fire that is not quenched." (Mk. 9:44) Jesus used another Greek Word to describe Hell's (Hades) fire. That is the word *Gehenna* (Matt. 18:9, Mark 9:43, Matt. 5:22, 29) Gehenna refers to a valley just outside Jerusalem. At the time of Jesus, this valley was the garbage dump. This was the place where garbage, trash and refuse were thrown. The carcasses of dead animals and the bodies of despised criminals were also cast into Gehenna to be burned. This fire burned all the time and Jesus said the worms do not die – so there is no annihilation.

The rich man of Luke 16:19-31 was cast into hell and he did not burn up. "And he cried out and said, 'Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water and cool off my tongue; for I am in agony in this flame." (Luke 16:24) He described his agony as being in a flame [of fire] and not just a broken relationship. He even went on to pray for his brothers lest they come to that place of torment. He did not burn up and cease to exist. How he wishes that he could have! This is not just a parable because Jesus addressed actual people of the day – "A CERTAIN rich man … a CERTAIN poor man named Lazarus." It is likely that the disciples knew these people.

"Just as Sodom and Gomorrah and the cities around them, since they in the same way as these indulged in gross immorality and went after strange flesh, are exhibited as an example, in undergoing the punishment of eternal fire." (Jude 7) Compare this with the Scripture at the top of the page and you see that the fire is eternal and the torment is eternal with no annihilation.

The specific Scriptures that deal with the final judgment and eternity also bear the truth that people are not annihilated, but are in a state of eternal punishment.

The Beast of Revelation (a literal man, the antichrist) is stated that he will go to destruction. "*The beast that you saw was and is not, and is about to come up out of the abyss and to go to destruction.*" (Revelation 17:8) This is the same exact Greek word used in the previous Scriptures noted. He is later cast into the lake of fire. "*And the beast was seized, and with him the false* prophet who performed the signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image; these two were thrown alive into the lake of fire which burns with brimstone." (Revelation 19:20) 1,000 years later the devil is also thrown into this lake of fire and the beast is still there! "And the devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are also; and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever." (Rev. 20:10). Destruction does not mean annihilation.

At the final Judgment, the ungodly will be emptied out of Hades, re-united with their re-constructed body, shown why they are deserving of damnation, then thrown into The Lake of Fire. "And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire." (Revelation 20:15) As eternity unfolds as described in Revelation 21-22, there is no indication that they will be annihilated, because further references in these very chapters in Revelation looks at them as still being there! "But for the cowardly and unbelieving and abominable and murderers and immoral persons and sorcerers and idolaters and all liars, their part will be in the lake that burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death." (Revelation 21:8) "And nothing unclean and no one who practices abomination and lying, shall ever come into it [the holy city], but only those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life. (Rev. 21:27) "Outside [of the holy city] are the dogs and the sorcerers and the immoral persons and the murderers and the idolaters, and everyone who loves and practices lying." (Rev. 22:15) Three times in these two chapters in Revelation, which describe the eternal abode of mankind, contains references to the ungodly as still in this lake of fire. They are not burned up or annihilated.

This teaching of annihilation denies the immortality of the soul, because the soul ceases to exist when it is burned up. This will be the topic for next month's issue: *Is the Soul of Man Immortal?*

It is easy, in trying to do a work for God, to rely on human abilities and devices, but these will fail, for the battle is the Lord's. When the battle is going well, we must not boast for the battle is the Lord's. When the battle is going hard, we must not despair, for the battle is the Lord's.

He is our strength. "For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strongholds)" (II Corinthians 10:3,4).

In the famous Sermon on the Mount, Jesus spoke to His disciples saying: "Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we wear? Or, What shall we drink? Or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? "(For after all these **things** do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these **things**. But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these **things** shall be added unto you. Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the **things** of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof." (Matt. 5:31-34)

Jesus is warning people here about living for **things.** In Luke 12:15 He says, "A man's life consistenth not in the abundance of the **things** which he possesseth."

Earlier, Jesus had warned that men could not serve both God and mammon. He indicated that all of us would have to make a choice between spiritual and eternal values in contrast to possessions, money and worldly goods.

William Jennings Bryan said, "Those who live for money spend half of their lives getting it and the other half keeping others from getting it and they don't enjoy it either."

Someone asked Mr. Rockefeller, "How much does it take to satisfy a man?" His answer: "Just a little more."

The apostle Paul, who had forsaken all to follow Christ, said, "As having nothing, and yet possessing all things" (II Cor.6 :10). The word "nothing" is really two words–no thing. In spite of the fact that Paul had no possessions, he claimed to possess all things.

The story is told of a man crossing a desert. He disappeared and was never heard of again. Several years later someone found his bones and beside the skeleton were several bags of money and jewels, but no drinking water. He had been so wrapped up in things that he forgot one of life's most essential needs, water.

Men spend their health getting wealth and then spend their wealth trying to get back their health. Hundreds of people are wrapped up in this silly race and have never learned to live.

The Revival Beginning in 1925

The spiritual life in the community had ebbed out. There were lights that continued to burn; lay people met occasionally for prayer and meditation.

A testimony by William Windahl

From my earliest childhood, I was conscious of the indwelling of the Trinity in my heart. The prayers we were taught to pray at meal-time and before going to bed to sleep at night filled me with the knowledge and presence of Jesus.

Born on June 16, 1901, at Ellerth, Minnesota, seven miles west of Newfolden, we as children were blest with born-again, pietistic grandparents and parents, who brought us to the Lord in baptism, to Sunday School, a month-long parochial (today called VBS), church, prayer meetings, evangelistic meeting and, eventually, confirmation.

As I grew older, I did not commit my life openly or publicly to Christ, but tried to live a *secret* Christian life. I had fellowship with Jesus, but did not have assurance of salvation, but constantly prayed that God would convert me.

In 1922, I left for Minneapolis to study art at the Minneapolis School of Art. One day, I went to a store to buy an item for my art work. I observed that the owner of the store had a strong Norwegian accent. He was friendly and asked me what I was doing in the city. He invited me to their Young People's meeting that coming Sunday night. I asked him what denomination his church belonged to and he informed me that it was the Norwegian Evangelical Free Church. Surely, this was God's leading. I attended their services and the second time the beloved Christians helped me to take an open stand for Christ. After some months of spiritual battle, the Holy Spirit led me to assurance of salvation based on His promises. My conversion was as revolutionary as if I had been the robber on the cross. I experienced an overwhelming joy, peace and love.

When I returned home to Newfolden, the Free Evangelical pastor there had heard that I had been saved in their Minneapolis-located church and desired that I should join their church. Being a strong Lutheran of the Haugean spirit, I had no inclination to change.

When I was saved, God gave me a tremendous burden for my unsaved brothers and sisters and our home community. We did not know of any confessing young person in our church. The old Christians in our Bethesda congregations, as well as in the Lutheran Free Church, were still praying for revival and an awakening.

Through a male chorus that came to Newfolden and sang in the Lutheran Free Church, Rev. John Hjelmeland,

pastor, I became acquainted with the Lutheran Brethren Synod with headquarters and schools in Grand Forks, North Dakota. The following year, I was enrolled as a student there and joined their male chorus singing first tenor. The director, Prof. Alfred Bridston, again arranged a tour in the Newfolden community, and in our church. The day came when we started for Newfolden. Previous to this, I had had a dream in which I saw a fresh mound, a grave where one of my unsaved relatives had just been buried. As we rode along in the old bus, I was so burdened for the unsaved in our community that I literally felt sick.

We sang in our home church, Bethesda, that evening, and I noticed young people, who were moved. We had no concert planned for the next day, Friday afternoon, and the church elders asked if we could stay for another service, which we did. That afternoon, we experienced a Heavensent awakening. The hearts of several young people were stirred, convicted and yielded to God. Those, who came that day, were two of my sisters, Esther (Mrs. A. A. Pederson) and Florence (Mrs. Carl Haugen), brother, Arnold, and sister-in-law, (Mrs. Arthur Windahl), and cousin, William Lein.

This was a beginning of a revival, and awakening, which continued in Newfolden, bringing many souls to Christ.

Do Not Love The World

"Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him." (I John 2:15)

It will soon be fall and hunting season. There is a phenomenon that happens in rural areas particularly around Minneapolis and Chicago at that time of the year. An amazing number of cattle are shot. You get all these city slickers who have never set foot in the country before, who all of a sudden decide that they are going to be deer hunters. They go out in the country and they will see an animal and say, "My what a beautiful deer". "No sir that's a cow", "Are you sure it's not a deer?" "No, it's a cow, it says moo, please if it says moo, don't shoot it." If it looks like a cow, if it acts like a cow, and if it sound's like a cow, it's not a deer, it's a cow.

We use that logic in the physical realm all the time, but somehow things get fuzzy when we talk about the spiritual. You see somebody that looks like the world, they act like the world, and they sound like the world, but they profess to be a Christian, they were baptized, they said a prayer. We're not supposed to look objectively and logically at that person and say, they look like the world, there is a possibility that they are not saved. Scriptures says anyone who loves the world, the love of the Father is not in Him. John makes it pretty clear.

Look at the church, read the statistics, the sexual immorality, divorce, the power struggles within the church, the division. Just think about it, there are things that people who call themselves Christians do today that even 50 years ago the non-Christians wouldn't have done unless it was in the darkness of night. But today the Church celebrates it. The church, even the evangelical church is involved in so many worldly pursuits, it's no wonder there is a spiritual famine going on.

Do not love the world. The word translated love? Yes it's a form of the word Agape, the way it's used here it means: "to take pleasure in the thing, prize it above other things, be unwilling to abandon it or do without it"

Do not love the world. Do not take pleasure in the world, don't prize the world above the things of God, be willing to abandon the world, to do without it.

How is this possible? How can you not love the world, it has such a pull on us? John is not in this epistle laying down the way of salvation, but the tests to see if the kind of faith you have is truly saving faith. There is only one way to not love the world, be converted, be saved, have a new heart, be born again. If you are not saved, you won't love God's word, and treasure it, meditate on it, and memorize it. If God hasn't removed your heart of stone and given you a new heart, the last place you want to be is with other Christians.

We need to understand that Christianity is not just "Do not touch, do not taste, do not handle". Because the doing or not doing won't save you. You can do all the right things for all the wrong reasons. But what John is talking about is a supernatural work of God in your life so you now want to do the right things because you love God and your desire is to please him.

Our world knows practically nothing about that kind of conversion anymore. The process of salvation, the awakening to our need, the sorrow for sin, probably even a striving to forsake sin under our own strength, but suffering defeat, but then the sweet surrender to Jesus and a changed life. Is that what you have experienced?

Hans Nielsen Hauge grew up in a very godly home, they attended church regularly, had family devotions, now everyone today and even in his day would say that Hans Hauge was already a Christian. Nothing more needs to be done, just be faithful in church and receive the sacraments and you'll be OK. But young Hauge sensed otherwise and kept praying and seeking. One day while he was working out in the field, he was meditating and singing The Hymn "Jesus, I Long For Thy Blessed Communion", and this is what he said happened.

"My heart was so uplifted to God that I don't know nor can I express what took place in my soul. As soon as my understanding returned, I regretted that I hadn't served the loving and all-gracious God; now I felt that no worldly thing was of importance. It was a glory which no tongue can explain; my soul felt something supernatural, divine, and blessed... I had a completely transformed mind, a sorrow over all sins, a burning desire that others should share the same grace, a particular desire to read the Scriptures, especially Jesus' own teachings as well as new light to understand them and the teachings of godly men; toward the one goal: that Christ has come to be our Savior, that we should be born again by His spirit, be converted, and be sanctified more and more in godliness, to serve the triune God alone in order to improve and prepare our souls for the eternal blessedness." Wrestling in Prayer, 1

"Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation." (Mark 14:38)

MOST of us cannot quite understand how prayer can involve difficulty and anguish. Why should praying entail so much suffering? Why should our prayer life be a constant source of anguish?

If we will reflect but for a moment, we will, however, see that it really cannot be otherwise. If prayer is, as we have seen, the central function of the new life of faith, the very heart-beat of our life in God, it is obvious that our prayer life must become the target against which Satan directs his best and most numerous darts.

He understands better than we do what prayer means to ourselves and to others. That is why his chief attack is directed against our prayer life. If he can in one way or in another weaken it, his prospects of stealing our life in God without us even noticing it are of the very best.

This is not only the most painless way of stealing from us our spiritual life; it is also the quietest way, the way which creates the least sensation. Satan desires above all to provide himself with servants who think that they are God's children and who are even looked upon as children of God by others.

For this reason Satan mobilizes everything that he can commandeer in order to hinder our prayer. He has an excellent confederate in our own bosoms: our old Adam. Our carnal nature is, according to the Scriptures and our own bitter experience, enmity against God (Romans 8:7); and our old nature realizes that it can expect nothing but mortification every time we really approach God in prayer.

It is important for us to bear this clearly in mind. By so doing we will, in the first place, be able to account for something which we formerly could not understand, namely, the aversion to prayer which we feel more or less strongly from time to time. Our disinclination to pray should not make us anxious or bewildered. It should merely substantiate to us the old truth that the "flesh lusteth against the spirit." We shall have our carnal natures with us as long as we live here below, and we must endure the discomfiture occasioned thereby.

We should deal with the unwillingness of our flesh in this respect in the same way as we deal with all the other sinful desires of our flesh. We should take it to God and lay it all before Him. And the blood of Jesus Christ will cleanse us from this sin as it does from all other sin.
