Hauge's Activity

(Continued from October issue of Morning Glory)

or a closer understanding of Hauge's activity and how a man in so short a time could accomplish so much, we must first emphasize his conversations with the individuals.

As mentioned before, Hauge began his activity with individual conversations, and this was also very essential in his mission. Hauge must have been especially gifted in this respect. He had great spiritual experience and his spiritual vision was penetrating. His speech was lively, and he made everything intelligible by examples, illustrations and pictures. His words seemed to carry the weight of eternity, even when he spoke only a couple of words in passing, so it is exemplified that a few words from him stayed in the souls of some for 40 to 60 years without losing their power, and above all he had a glowing, burning love, which pervaded his heart, and against this his quiet, strong love could almost no weapon hold its own There are examples also that he with almost magic strength held his most enraged opponent only by a friendly word or a kind pat on the shoulder.

He generally started his conversation with worldly-minded people about temporal things and went from there easily over to the spiritual. In entering a house his first words were as a rule: "Do you live well here?" a question which often awoke earnest thoughts. Time and again he talked to the individual like this: "Will you become a brother in Christ?" or he laid his hand on the person's head and asked: "Will you love God?" etc...

His friends often came from afar to talk with him, and they always found guidance and consolation with him in the Word of God. One writes about this: "As I arrived at

the said place, I talked with the man whom I a long time had wanted to meet I became much confirmed in his edification as he knew both in teaching and in living how to lead the weak and convince the recalcitrant." Another says: "The Word of God bore testimony to me that he spoke the truth, and I felt I absolutely could not resist, and he was also very friendly towards everybody, even the lowliest, so that clearly gave evidence that he must have Christ's disposition, as I never before had seen such a person."

Hauge's Edification Speeches

Hauge's Edification Speeches were flowing freely from his deep and fervent life in God, not according to scientific rules, but there were in them the abundance of such faith and love which rendered effect. Hauge never studied his sermons, for if he had there would have been less warmth and fervency in them but not more light and serenity, as it was the power of life that worked. He himself tells that when he had figured out how he should preach in order to convince the wicked and edify the faithful, it nearly came to a stop for him; but when he resigned himself unto God and asked Him to control his tongue, it always came easy for him to talk about the walks of life. That is why he held to the promise: "It shall be given you in that same hour what ye shall speak."

One of his listeners says: "<u>His word and speech were</u> over my heart as a double-edged sword. As he began to speak the Word of God, my heart became so agitated with astonishment over his love and gentle mind, as I had never heard anyone speak as he did." His speeches were very vivid and well suited to fascinate the listeners' hearts.

Hauge's edifications were attended by many people;

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often large crowds gathered on the highways to follow him to the place where he had appointed edification. Old people have said that when such preocessions went by, one would almost be moved to go along...

Hauge's Co-Workers

Hauge's co-workers were the many who either affected by Hauge personally or by his publications felt the urge to go out and bear testimony for their follow men about the one thing needful. These co-workers were called "lay-preachers." Hauge admonished his friends to pray God to awaken teachers of truth who would proclaim the Word of God in spirit and truth, He says in part: "As Christ with divine strength has emancipated us from the power and domination of sin, then we are anointed with the ointment of Christ of God's love. We have oil in our lamps, shouldn't we then preach his Word and confess his will even to the wicked race?"

Gradually there was a great number of these lay-preachers around the country, and their work was of much blessing, so sinners were awakened from their indifference and began to love Jesus.

For whosoever shall do the will of God, the same is my brother, and my sister, and mother.





First Fruits of Agape (Divine) Love

1. Take the challenge! Get prepared. Go to boot





SUNDAYS (The LORD'S Day) HAVE BECOME DESECRATED

Sundays have become **so busy** that <u>many Congregations/Churches NOW HAVE</u> (across the board) WORSHIP SERVICES during the 'work-week'!

MY *Question* is: **'busy'** *doing what* – on what we call the LORD'S DAY???

I know EVERY 'day' is a gift from God and every day should be lived for HIM!

GOD says REMEMBER THE SABBATH DAY – in Luther's Small Catechism Explained it states:

"How is this done?" "When God destroys and brings to naught every evil counsel and purpose of the devil, the world, and our own flesh, which would hinder us from hallowing His Name, and prevent the coming of His kingdom; and when He strengthens us and keeps us steadfast in His Word and in faith even unto our end. This is His good and gracious will."

REMEMBER THE SABBATH DAY, TO KEEP IT HOLY.

<u>"What does this mean?"</u> "*Answer:*" "We should fear and love God so that we do not despise His Word and the preaching of the same, but deem it holy, and gladly hear and

learn it."

"Which day is the day of rest among Christians? Sunday, the first day of the week, on which Christ rose from the dead."

"How should we keep the day of rest holy? 1. We must rest from our daily labor, that the time may be used for our instruction in the fear of the Lord. 2. We must earnestly hear and study the word of God, both in our homes and in church.

"And He said, 'More than that, blessed are those who hear the word of God and keep it!" **Luke 11:28** "Pure and undefiled religion before God and the Father is this; to visit orphans and widows in their trouble, and to keep oneself unspotted from the world." **James 1:27**

SUNDAYS have become sleep-in-day, sports, fun-day, catch-up-day, mow the lawn, wash the car, laundry, work day; a day to do just what (I) want to do; other than obey the Word of God.

Psalm 19:7-10.

Fourthly: The empowering, in and through and with the Eternal Word of God in **8:18.** This is putting the Word of God into ACTION through vessels to His Honor and Glory! *Church and the Assembly of 'believers'* is not a DRUDGERY! The Word of God is the Primary Focus and that is why we don't resort to using secondary means. God does not (*necessarily*) want to use "US" as Long (lone) Ranger Christians.

Forty-One Companies That Donate Directly to Planned Parenthood

In the wake of two videos allegedly showing Planned Parenthood officials discussing the sale of aborted fetal body parts, Republicans in Congress are working to ensure that Planned Parenthood is stripped of its federal funding

However, it's not only the government that fills Planned Parenthood's coffers. According to 2ndVote, a website and app, that the flow of money from consumers to political causes, more than twenty-three percent of Planned Parenthood's \$1.3 billion annual revenue comes from private donations which includes corporate contributions.

2ndVote researched the corporations and organizations to find which ones supported Planned Parenthood and found that more than three dozen donated to the group. Some companies donated directly, while others matched employee gifts.

Forty-one corporations and organizations directly contribute to the group...

The first video...showed Planned Parenthood senior executive Dr. Deborah Nucatola meeting with actors portraying buyers from a "human biologics company." The "buyers" discussed the sale of fetal body parts with Nucatola over lunch.

In the second video (Ed. NOW: Number of more 'videos' confirming same basic reality), released (July 21), Dr. Mary Gatter, president of Planned Parenthood's medical directors council, is seen negotiating the price of aborted fetal body parts.

Komen, Tostitos, Unilever, United Way Verizon, Wells Fargo, Xerox.

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Jesus Christ Our Creator

"For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers; all things were created by him, and for him." Colossians 1:16

Before one can really know Jesus Christ as Savior or Lord, he must acknowledge Him as offended and rejected Creator, because He was our Creator first of all. This is such an important doctrine of the New Testament that it is remarkable how rarely it is emphasized in modern evangelicalism.

Creation by Jesus Christ is the doctrine with which John begins his great gospel of salvation. "In the beginning was the Word, ...All things were made by him; ...and the world was made by him and the world knew him not" (John 1:1, 3, 10). It is the foundational message of the book of Hebrews: "God...hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds" (Hebrews 1:1-2).

The apostle Paul said that he had been called specifically to preach "the unsearchable riches of Christ; And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ" (Ephesians 3:8-9). When a person becomes a believer in Christ, receiving His very life by the new birth, he is said to be "renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him" (Colossians 3:10).

In the final book of the Bible, Jesus Christ is called "the beginning of the creation of God" (3:14). But of all the biblical passages identifying Jesus Christ as Creator, the most definitive of all is our text for today. Everything in heaven and Earth was created by Him, and for Him! "For of him, and through him, and to him, are all things: to whom be glory for ever. Amen" (Romans 11:36)

The Unity of the Book

The Bible consists of sixty-six books – thirty-nine in the Old Testament, twenty-seven in the New – written by forty different men over a period of sixteen hundred years. These men varied widely in their backgrounds and accomplishments.

The pages were penned in the wilderness of Sinai, the cliffs of Arabia, the hills and towns of Palestine, the courts of the temple, the schools of the prophets, the palace of Shushan, on the banks of the river Chebar in Babylon, on the lonely isle of Patmos, and in prisons and dungeons where Paul was inspired to write some of the books in the Bible.

Yet in all the Bible, in this wonderful conglomeration, is an absolute unity of thought and not one contradiction.

How could a herdsman, a tax collector, a statesman, a learned man, and an ignorant fisherman – living centuries apart – write down their thoughts, bring them together, and find that there was complete unity and harmony with a single contradiction?

I could choose forty like-minded men today, hand each a pad of blank paper and say to one, "Write a book of about eight chapters"; and to another "Write a book of about sixty-six chapters; and to another "Write a book of about forty chapters."

If I gave assignments to forty different men and they went off and wrote on their own, when they brought back their writings, it would be such a confusing mess that we would never be able to get it all together. There would be contradictions all the way through.

The only way it could come back having unity of thought would be to have a mastermind behind it, telling each one what to write.

There is perfect harmony and unity all the way through the Bible. As a matter of fact, there is such unity that you can't fully understand Hebrews without under-



BEYOND measure it is desirable that we, as believer, should have the person of Jesus constantly before us, to inflame our love towards Him, to increase our knowledge of Him. I would to God that my readers were all entered as diligent scholars in Jesus' college, students of Corpus Christi, or the body of Christ, resolved to attain unto a good degree in the learning of the cross. Being Thankful for Grace

"Moreover the law entered, that the offense might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound." Romans 5:20

This is the day which Americans set aside to reflect on the blessings of God which have been showered on us in the previous year. All other holidays, even Christmas and Easter, can be skewed into a non-Christian meaning, but not Thanksgiving. Historically, it was a time to give thanks to God for the bountiful harvest, and experientially, while there are those to whom we should give thanks for particular favors, there is only one to whom we can give thanks for the blessings of life. Nothing else makes sense.

Christians, of course, have much more for which to give thanks than the non-believer, or at least they have the eyes with which to see and the heart with which to recognize God's blessings. Indeed, Paul instructs us that "in everything (we should) give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you" (1 Thessalonians 5:18); the tense of the verb implying a habitual, continual thanksgiving.

But specifically, we should be thankful for His grace, which, as explained in our text, completely overwhelmed our sin and instead brought salvation and freedom from guilt. "For by grace are ye saved through faith, and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God" (Ephesians 2:8).

Note that in our text the word "<u>abound</u>" appears three times. Both the offense and sin exist in abundance. But the abundance of grace comes from a different Greek word which means literally "<u>to exist in superabundance</u>." But there is more. It is further modified by the prefix "<u>much more</u>," implying a grace that is beyond superabundance.

On this special day of thanksgiving, let us not fail to include in those things for which we are thankful the overwhelmingly superabundant grace of God.

Praise the LORD Psalm 150:1

THE evening was "darkness" and the morning was "light," and yet the two together are called by the name that is given to the light alone! This is somewhat remarkable, but it has an exact analogy in spiritual experience. In every believer there is darkness and light, and yet he is not to be named a sinner because there is sin in him, but he is to be named a saint because he possesses some degree of holiness. This will be a most comforting thought to those who are mourning their infirmities, and who ask, "Can I be a child of God while there is so much darkness in me?" Yes; for you, like the day, take not your name from the evening,

but from the morning; and you are spoken of in the word of God as if you were even now perfectly holy as you will be soon. You are called the child of light, though there is darkness in you still. You are named after what is the predominating quality in the sight of God, which will one day be the only principle remaining. Observe that the evening comes first. Naturally we are darkness first in order of time, and the gloom is often first in our mournful apprehension, driving us to cry out in deep humiliation, "God be merciful to me, a (Ed. lost) sinner." The place of the morning is second, it dawns when grace overcomes nature. It is a blessed aphorism of John Bunyan, "That which is last, lasts for ever." That which is first, yields in due season to the last; but nothing comes after the last. So that though you are naturally darkness, when once you become light in the Lord, there is no evening to follow; "thy sun shall no more go down." The first day in this life is an evening and a morning; but the second day, when we shall be with God, for ever, shall be a day with no evening, but one, sacred, high, eternal noon.
