Creation Vs. Evolution

Socialism), but all the same, it is we who will finally beat you... believe me, it is we who will win, for we BELIEVE in our *Communist message*, and we are ready to sacrifice everything, even our lives, in order that social justice shall triumph. But you Christians ARE AFRAID TO SOIL YOUR HANDS."

Therefore, should not our judicial system also reject

these <u>evolutionary TEACHINGS</u> from the curriculum of our schools? Because, is it not a deliberate, planned religious, or in essence *anti-religious INTRUSION* by a few, upon the constitutional RIGHTS of millions of Americans? Is it not also a clear violation of our high and noble principle of separation of Church (any religion or anti-religion) and State?

The old Testament prophet Hosea aptly describes this situation (Hosea 10:4b GNB) "Justice has become INJUSTICE, growing like *poisonous weeds* in a PLOWED FIELD."

And the New Testament inspired Apostle Paul WARNS:

5. President Abraham Lin-

coln in his <u>Gettysburg Address</u> emphasized "that this nation, <u>UNDER GOD</u>, shall have a new birth of freedom – and that government <u>OF</u> the people, <u>BY</u> the people, <u>FOR</u> the people, shall not perish from the earth."

6. The Father of our country, <u>GEORGE WASHING-</u><u>TON</u>, boldly affirmed:

"It is impossible to rightly govern the world without **GOD** and the **BIBLE.**

Is not this in part our basic national and historical Heritage, together with the clear, distinct and honest separation of Church and State? And does this not mean, that there must be a *SINGLE STANDARD OF JUSTICE for ALL* members of ALL religions in our land, including ALL anti-Christian, and God-less atheists, as a religious or anti-religious sect and a legal entity, but <u>equally respon-</u> sible with ALL citizens for their teaching and practice?

Real Christian Love

Romans 13:8-10

A tremendous need for genuine Christian love exists today. Oh yes, there is an abundance of talk about love in Christian circles, but much of what is considered "love" is a pseudo, unscriptural love. In the name of "love" Christian leaders are welcoming "wolves in sheep's clothing" into the flock rather than exposing them and separating from them. Many believers are being deceived into thinking that "love" is always positive – never negative; they are remaining in compromising fellowships because they have been erroneously taught that to separate from brethren in Christ is "unloving," but exactly the opposite is true (2 Thess. 3:6, 14-15). Separation from disobedient brethren (of which there are many today) is a genuine manifestation of Christian love for them. Failure to separate from them and admonish them demonstrates a lack of concern for their spiritual welfare as well as the well-being of those who are influenced by their unscriptural teachings.

Our text stresses the importance of genuine Christian love by making it a fulfillment of the Law – an evidence of complete obedience to God's Word and will. First Corinthians 13 also instructs us concerning the importance of Christian love in an even more comprehensive way. The true love of God cannot be separated from truth or from speaking what is needful (Eph. 4:15). If we truly love the unsaved, we will give them the Gospel, refusing to dilute the facts in an attempt to avoid offense. If we truly love our fellow believers, we will declare "all the counsel of God" – never modifying nor neglecting any needed Biblical reproof (Acts 20:18 - 32). M. H. Reynolds

UNSOLICITED ADVICE

Someone said: "<u>Unsolicited advice is seldom heeded</u> and often scorned," but the Bible says, "*A wise man will hear, and will increase learning*" (Prov. 1:5).

Have you ever pondered the great variety of trees that grow in America and around the world? The Lord knows what we need, and He gave us a large variety of trees to fulfill many purposes. I have a number of woodworking tools and love to make various things from different kinds of wood. The various trees are mentioned more than three hundred times in Scripture. It was at a tree in Eden that the human race got into trouble and at a tree on Mount Calvary where our redemption was secured.

There are several varieties of trees in my yard, most of which are pine. The largest pine is well over one hundred feet tall, and my arms cannot encircle it at the base. But my favorite trees, of which we have only two, are the oak trees. One of them grows just outside my office window. We planted a flower garden around this tree, and I look at it every day when we are at home.

While the pine tree that I mentioned is enormous, the oak trees are not so big. The one outside my office is perhaps forty feet tall and eight to ten inches in diameter at the base. There are several things we can do concerning this tree.

First of all, we can just watch it grow and admire its beauty. This is probably what we will do as long as my wife and I live here. On the other hand, I could cut the tree down and use it for firewood. After a few years, when it gets larger, I could have it cut up into lumber.

Oak lumber is very expensive because it is a superior wood and has many applications. Another use would be have it milled into furniture grade wood. So we can go from little value (heat) to great worth (furniture) depending upon how we use the tree.

The life of an individual can go from a burden to society (prisoner) to a national hero (soldier). Writing in II Timothy 2:20, Paul said, "But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and of silver, but also of wood and of earth; and some to honour, and some to dishonor."

Scripture likens people unto vessels fit or unfit for the Master's use. Most people do not want to eat out of a dirty vessel, and the Lord cannot use anyone that has not been washed in the blood of the Lamb.

Now God wants to use everyone that gets saved, but some lives are too marred by sin that they may never attain to the gold and silver level of use by the Lord. But vessels of wood and earth still have much use and can be very helpful. If we will teach our children to flee youthful lusts and follow righteousness, they may someday be golden vessels for the Lord's use.

Even as sin-stained adults, we can still do much for the Lord as broken and remade vessels. The Lord sent Jeremiah to the potter's house where he saw a vessel marred in the hand of the potter, but it was remade as seemed good to the potter. We are as clay in the Potter's hand; and if we yield our lives, God will make us meet [fit] for the Master's use.

Do you want to be cut down and used for firewood, or would you like to be milled and refined for something of great value to the Lord? The choice is yours. If you have been broken by the sins of this world, why don't you yield your life to the great Master Builder and let him remake your life? —The Sword of the Lord

RES ALLEGORIES

"In the beginning" (Genesis 1:1a). "For I am the LORD, I do not change" (Malachi 3:6a). "Jesus Christ is the same, yesterday, today, and forever" (Hebrews 13:8). "If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land" (II Chronicles 7:14).

Today 'our' culture/society is very much 'sportsminded'; which shouldn't catch 'us' by surprise: because GOD stated so many years ago that this would come to pass, likely shortly before the "<u>Trumpet Sound</u>"! WE speak of this in the period of time, as PERILOUS TIMES! – "lovers of pleasures rather than lovers of God" II Timothy 3.

IN our above text we have probably the best known BIBLE verse in all of II Chronicles. Solomon had <u>prayed</u> and this is the second time that God revealed himself to Solomon in the <u>night</u> (By the way, the Morning Star appears in the darkest part of the 'night' which is just before DAWN (Revelation22:16). Thus God has promised to answer the prayers of His people that they should make any time in that place – v. 13-15.

National judgments are here supposed (v. 13): Famine, Pestilence, and perhaps war as the locusts devouring the land may be meant as greedy enemies laying it all waste. National repentance, prayer, and reformation are REQUIRED for healing; and as You and I know, a Nation is made up of **Individual persons.**

A SIN that every single one of 'us' have a consistent 'battle' with is "I". This battle against SIN goes way back to CREATION or even before! Notice what Satan said (LU C I F E R) in Isaiah 14:12-15. And then shortly after CREATION, Eve - Genesis 3 (Adam) and ever since! NO individual person has very had total victory over this SIN, except JESUS and HE even was tempted with Pride. L U C (I) F E R, S I N, P R I D E all have "I" in the very center! One thing you don't thank GOD for your is 'hu*mility*'; because pride would show up it's ugly face again! IN Second Chronicles Seven, National MERCY is then promised If the people do as prescribed. Then God will forgive their sin; which is also VERY MUCH NEEDED in our USA and beyond. AS then *pardoning MERCY* makes way for healing mercy! Those who believe must forsake their sins, turn from the life that is centered in self (I), and yield to God's Word and Will. Then, and only then, will Heaven send a revival.

Now I am led up to the 'Allegories' of which I am going to

use the two 'sports' of Baseball and Football. I am not very intelligent about either one. (By the way, 'sports' are not wrong in themselves; but the priorities which people place upon them).

In the sport of Baseball, try to think of the *possibility* of 4 Balls and 3 strikes equally OR in Football, 4 Touchdowns and 3 Field-goals.

FIRST OF ALL, every individual person who wants to actively participate in the 'sport' MUST meet certain qualifications and abide by absolute regulations – Right? They also must practice and use discipline.

In our text, the first qualification for national restoration is for the people to "<u>humble themselves</u>". A participant can not seek to live above the 'requirements' of the sport NOR can people seek to live above God's Word. (Even in our great Land (USA), 'we' are not to seek to live above the Constitution). God intends that basically Government is not to be a source/means of mercy; but of <u>Justice</u>. Most certainly as a believer: "*Remember the word that I said to you*, 'A servant is not greater than his master.' If they persecute Me, they will also persecute you, 'If they kept My word, they will keep yours also.'" John 15:20

So, in a sport, we don't make the 'rules' as we go along, but follow the 'rules' that have already been set IN PLACE, and in so doing, the participant has <u>great</u> <u>FREEDOM</u>. You and I have a lot of 'freedom' as long as 'we' abide and obey His Word – Guidelines. **John 8:31-36.**

You see, it is 'freedom' from and 'freedom unto': FREEDOM from Condemnation, Judgment (Rev. 20:11-15) and then 'freedom' unto/into; which is in service to the '<u>Commander-in-Chief'</u> (*Coach, Manager*).

President John F. Kennedy said, "It's not so much what can my Government do for me, but what can I do for my Country." We have freedom to serve, not destroy!

Hans Neilsen Hauge said, "A Christian is 'free' from the LAW, but not compliance to the LAW."

The LAW (regulations, rules) is <u>good</u> for US: 1Timothy 1:8, Romans 7:7-18a.

As you know an Umpire/Referee has to make many in-

stant calls and thus making a decision without any replays. He is, however, open to possible *error*. God's guidelines are <u>forever</u> settled in Heaven, regardless of what man thinks in his pride. (Duet. 32:5-6) HIS RULE-BOOK is 'our' plumb line regardless of our opinion or choice. Isaiah 5:20, Proverbs 2:1-5.

IF you do not play according to the Guidance Book, you will be disqualified. If you have **3 strikes** or incomplete passes, you are missing the MARK of what is aimed for! <u>SIN is missing the</u> *'mark'* and then admitting 'we' are wrong. *"For whoever shall keep the whole law and yet stumble in one point, he is guilty of all."* James 2:10, Romans 3:10-23.

MARVELOUS and GREAT is the **Gift of Salvation** that we by no means can fully comprehend it on this side of ETERNITY! Just 'ponder' for awhile (present tense) the 'value' that God places on you and me, and He clearly states that heaven rejoices over ONE sinner truly repenting of their SIN and accepting **Jesus** as the ONLY deliverance from our personal SINS. *What mercy, grace, love* the Umpire/Referee places on us.

There are 'injuries' that take place in these 'sports'. For us, these injuries are not on the sports field/gridiron, but Spiritually in the battle field unto Heaven.

I have a friend who was a 'soldier' during the Second World War and he tells of a 'battle' that he personally was involved in against the enemy when they never took their combat boots off for nearly <u>forty days</u>. YES, 'our' spiritual battle is even more intense, which is combat against our own flesh (self-life), the world and Satan. It is so intense that it is like hand-to-hand combat with bayonets! The end result is either **Heaven or Hell** for ALL ETERNITY!

No doubt how great it is to hit a home-run or make a touch-down, and it takes a 'team effort' to accomplish these, even though we are responsible for <u>specifically</u> one person: myself.

A loyal, faithful 'player' will seek to reach their goal with continual practice and discipline, and hopefully become an example/testimony unto others. As <u>soldier</u> of the CROSS, there is no room for retreat OR giving up. Thus forgetting those things which are behind and pressing on




THEREFORE

Remove the Ten Commandments

Oklahoma's Supreme Court on Tuesday [6/30/15] ruled that the state must remove its Ten Commandments monument at the state Capitol because it violates the state Constitution, which bans using public property for the benefit of religion.

In a 7-2 decision, justices found that the statute violated article 2, section 5 of the state's constitution, which says, "No public money or property shall ever be appropriated, applied, donated, or used, directly or indirectly, for the use, benefit, or support of any sect, church, denomination, or system of religion, or for the use, benefit, or support of any priest, preacher, minister, or other religious teacher or dignitary, or sectarian institution as such."

The justices ruled that "the Ten Commandments are obviously religious in nature and are an integral part of the Jewish and Christian faiths." The lawsuit was brought by the ACLU of Oklahoma on behalf of four plaintiffs. An Oklahoma County judge ruled last September that the monument could stay in place.

"I think that at the end of the day it is the right decision simply because it acknowledges limits on the government's power to effectively decide what religious edicts are right and wrong," said Brady Anderson, the legal director for ACLU of Oklahoma, according to Tulsa World.

A spokesman for Gov. Mary Fallin reacted with disappointment.

Religious Experiences

Could I virtue seek and good perform, All sinful longings kill, Have Thee my fortress in the storm, My rock and shield from ill; Then Satan's wiles and power That seek to work man harm Would cause me no alarm.

At this time I learned other hymns by heart. Among these were; "Ah, Knewest Thou, Who Walk Enslaved by Sin" and "O Lord God, Who Me in Grace Hast Given." The fourth stanza of this latter hymn runs as follows:

Confirm, O Lord, my heart By Thy most loving favor, To love Thee above all And as myself my neighbor. With patience may I bear The cross that comes to me, And when I prosper, grant That humble I may be.

I found much to live up to in these verses; love God and your neighbor; be humble when things go well and patient when you meet opposition. The same was true of the eighth stanza of "Jesus, Savior of the World" – on humility – and the second stanza of "Jesus, I Long for Thy Blessed Communion".

When traveling or working, I found that singing these hymns cheered one greatly. But although this edified me, and though I was of a quiet and patient disposition, my liking for fun carried me into various worldly enjoyments. I found pleasure in hunting and in card playing, indeed not for money but to the extent of a sinful waste of time. I engaged in trading, which was something that made me ill at ease, even though I liked it.

The older I grew, the more I lost my capacity for noble feeling. Various anxieties began to weigh heavily upon me as on different occasions I met with adversity and experienced fear. Terror over whelmed me when I was in the dark, just as if evil spirits were after me. Such things troubled me until I was twenty-five years old.

At this time I wanted to try to improve my personal fortunes, so I went to a suburb of Fredrikstand. Here I was exposed to many temptations by evil-minded companions. Up to this time I had abhorred drunkenness. But sometimes for lack of food, and other occasions presenting themselves, I soon took a liking to liquor. So much so that I think I could soon haven fallen into the vice of drunkenness. But as I realized that this would lead to the destruction of both my body and soul, I prayed to God that He would preserve me. There upon I received an aversion to this vice and by the grace of God was preserved from this temptation, so that I have not been drunk more than once in my life. And that occurred while I was in the above-mentioned city.

Finally, by prayerful reading of the Bible and other Christian books, I began to get more knowledge of God's will as well as the desire to do His will with my whole heart. Now I developed an aversion for all sins and talked about what I believed to others so that different ones began to make fun of me and call me "holy." Some people said that if I continued to devote so such time to reading, I would lose my mind. That was what had happened to many others who had read too much, they averred. I answered that I could not believe that those who meditated up God's Word would lose their minds but would rather gain wisdom to practice those things that are pleasing to God.

God also gave me grace to meditate more upon His will. I thought about His omnipotence and how much He had created for the good of us human beings. I reflected upon His immeasurable greatness and goodness. I sensed how wonderful it would be to be His child and believed that I could become this if I only had a true desire to do so. "Alas," I thought, "many seek to win honor and respect in the world. Some are proud because they are of a high social class or have parents that are rich in the things of this world. Of what help are these things in death! But to have God as Father, to be His child, surpasses anything the mind can comprehend." I cannot describe how exalted and happy I felt during such moments of contemplation.

But I know that I fell far short of truly being a child of God, especially in this: loving Him above all things and being humble of heart. I prayed a great deal for grace to practice these virtues and to learn to know His will, both what to do and what not to do. "If Thou, my Father, wilt give me power, create Thy love in my heart and preserve me in humility, then I will serve Thee with all my strength. I will sacrifice everything, even my own life, as did the early martyrs, rather than depart from Thy commandments." These and similar feelings filled my heart when I was alone, away from all human associations.

The desire to please God grew more and more. In prayer to Him, I would kneel in heartfelt unworthiness of the great goodness He had shown me, ashamed because I had not served the Lord as I ought. Sometimes I fell on my knees and prayed to almighty God for the sake of His son to establish me on the spiritual rock, Christ Jesus. For I believed then that even the gates of hell would be powerless against me. I called upon the God of my salvation to reveal His Son's love in me and grant His Holy Spirit to expose my wretchedness and impotence and teach me the way I should walk in order to follow in the footsteps of Christ.

One day while I was working outside under the open sky, I sang from memory the hymn, "Jesus, I Long for Thy Blessed Communion." I had just sung the second verse.

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David and His Mighty Men

2 Samuel 23:1-7

David was God's anointed and serves as a wonderful "type" of Christ. He was also the "sweet psalmist of Israel" (v. 1). What he spoke by inspiration of the Holy Spirit is recorded in the Bible for our learning – every word from his pen was "God breathed," allowing us to understand the greatness and the beauties of our Lord (vv. 1-5). When we see in Scripture David fulfilling his calling as the great king and deliverer of God's people Israel, we also see a picture of our Savior who leads the redeemed to victory after victory. It might seem at times that the ungodly have the upper hand, but their eventual defeat is certain (vv. 6-7). Like David, God's servants today must stand fast in these days of great difficulty.

Over the next several days we will consider a few of David's "mighty men" who faithfully served him in battle. Certain facts also come to mind concerning David himself when we study his men. First, their devotion and valor recorded in David's "last words" (v. 1) are a reflection of the training, piety and courage that he exemplified for them. If we do anything worthy of reward, then the actual credit will go to our Lord, as was true of the laurels given David's men. Second, the mighty men's Godliness directly correlated to their demonstrated bravery. A right relationship with the king fostered confidence in battle. Third, David's men often served in obscurity, but this chapter suggests eventual recognition. Whatever we do for Christ, whether or not anyone else notices or even cares, will be remembered. No saint will be a "nobody" when he finally stands before the Bema Seat of Christ.

The Truth

"And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables." 2 Timothy 4:4

This is the last of eleven occurrences of "<u>the truth</u>" in Paul's two letters to Timothy. He was not writing about the importance of being <u>truthful</u> in general, but about a specific body of factual information concerning Jesus Christ and its vital importance. Thus, "*the truth*" was a very important theme in both of Paul's letters to this young pastor – and, by implication, to all God-called pastors.

Paul first speaks of "the knowledge of the truth" as required for salvation (1 Timothy 2:4), then of his own teaching as "the living truth in Christ" (1 Timothy 2:7), then of "the church of the living God" as "the pillar and ground of the truth" (1 Timothy 3:15), and of Christians as those who "believe and know the truth" (1 Timothy 4:3). He stresses the importance of studying the Bible as "the word of truth" (II Timothy 2:15), and also that true repentance requires "the acknowledging of the truth" (2 Timothy 2:25).

Paul also warns of false and covetous teachers who are "destitute of the truth" (1 Timothy 6:5) and who therefore "concerning the truth have erred" (2 Timothy 2:18). There will even be false prophets who "resist the truth" and are "reprobate concerning the faith" (2 Timothy 3:8).

As a result of the teaching of these false teachers, there will be many so-called seekers of truth who are "ever learning," yet who seem "never able to come to the knowledge of the truth" (2 Timothy 3:7). The reason they never find the truth is because they "*turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables*" (2 Timothy 4:4).

The fact is that Jesus said: **"I am ... the truth"** and also that **"thy word is truth"** (John 14:6, 17:17). For any who would say with Pilate, "*What is truth*"? (John 18:38), there is the definitive answer!

GOD'S GATE

This is the gate of the Lord. Psalm 118:20

What is the gate for? It is used to provide entrance into an enclosure of some kind. God's kingdom is that kind of enclosure, having protective walls built around it. Notice the prayer of David in Psalm 51:18, "*Build thou the walls of Jerusalem*."

God does not intend to let just anyone or anything into His kingdom. But the rest of our text says, "the righteous shall enter." Who are these people? In Revelation 22:14 we read, "Blessed are they that wash their robes, that they may have the right to come to the trees of life, and may enter in by the gates into the city." Those who will be permitted to enter the gates of heaven one day are those who have entered the "gate of Salvation" and have had their robes washed in the blood of the Lamb (Revelation 7:14).

And what is the gate of salvation? Jesus says, "*I am the door; by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved.*" (John 10:9). Have you gone through this gate or this door? If you haven't done so (Ed. OR need to return) before, do it today. Move into the promises of God and into the finished work of Christ. You will not be sorry.

God is also inviting us to enter into new experiences with Him. Do not stand outside the gate and hesitate. This opportunity comes to you from the Lord. Make use of it.

On this 239th birthday of (old) America, there can be no doubt in anyone's mind that our country is completely different than the one that the founding fathers envisioned.

Beginning in the 1960's, powerful forces have worked to transform America from the land of the free-thinking and free-speaking to the land of emotion-driven reactionaries. A very similar transformation happened in Germany immediately prior to the Nazis taking over that country.

Twenty years ago, I wrote a novel about powerful media moguls who conspire to destroy morality and patriotism in America. But no publisher would touch the manuscript. I see now that it was ahead of its time.

While the propaganda battle has been waged in our culture during the ensuing years, good people (whom the late Jerry Falwell called the "moral majority") unfortunately decided to smash the snooze button. Only now are they suddenly waking up to find that it's almost too late.

They underestimated the power of the elite who control the media, academia, and yes, Hollywood. Many parents underestimated the power of Hollywood's influence on their children, and now, the children of Baby Boomers are waging a war against their parents' standards of morality.

While growing up in Egypt in the 1950s and 60s, I witnessed how Nasser, the county's dictator, used the media to create a "group think" throughout society. Now I am feeling déjà vu all over again.

Although many Americans feel ambushed by last week's Supreme Court decision, many of us, who had watched this movie in our countries of birth, had sought to warn the public again and again. But we were accused of being alarmist (often by good people). They never saw this coming.

Now everyone has seen how five unelected individuals can shred the Constitution. It is time to wake up! Or is it too late?

A generation that is biblically and historically illiterate, a generation that has replaced logic and reason with emotions and feeling, has given us people who shrug their shoulders and say, "If you can't beat them, join them." That is even more tragic than the loss of those who blatantly advocate for such transformation.

It is hard to resist the onslaught, however. The media throws around words like "equality" and "discrimination" and "love wins." Their deceptive words seem true and pure, but they are actually an endless flow of mud into a once-pristine sea.

So what is the answer?

People must unite and resist this mudslide that is destroying democracy in America. People of good will — and not just those who identify themselves as Evangelical Christians or Conservative Catholics or Orthodox Jews – must fight back.


